SALSA BABIES

Monday 2:30-3:30pm | Until October 23



With little ones snuggled in to baby carriers, Salsa Babies™ offers a great workout, a chance to socialize and an opportunity to introduce one's child to music and movement. Classes are appropriate for babies 6-8 weeks of age and up. Cost is \$89 for six weeks.

SMART COOKIE CLUB: TODDLER / PRESCHOOL CLASSES

The Smart Cookie Club is a play-based enrichment program catered for children aged 12 months – 4 years. Classes have a different learning focus each week and activities are built around a theme that touch on different developmental areas (communication and language, math, gross and fine motor skills, music, science and sensory, creative). Cost is \$292.50, includes one FREE make-up class.

SMART COOKIE CLUB: 6-12 MONTH INFANT CLASSES

Our aim for this session is to teach you about the different aspects of your child's development and show you some practical activities that can be easily replicated at home. The 6 week season includes: Fun, developmentally appropriate in-class activities; Weekly handouts outlining your child's development; Learning how to make some of your own resources; Take home activities; Support for parents and caregivers. Cost is \$135 for six weeks.

BOOGIE WONDERLAND: KIDS CHOREOGRAPHY DANCE CLASS FOR 6 – 8 YEARS

First half hour – low volume music and mingle and dance (talking is allowed during the dance for the first 1/2 hour only before the opening circle). Kids are welcome if they are able to follow the no talking rule and they want to dance (no running or disruptive activity on the dance floor). THE BRAIN STORM


September 23 11am-1pm
